Animal Rescue Foundation is an all-volunteer, no-kill, non-profit organization, founded in 1986 by Barbara Shea. Our mission is to help lost, unwanted, abused and abandoned cats, dogs, kittens and puppies. We hope to adopt them to loving forever homes but, when necessary, we are their forever home. Before being offered for adoption all our pets are vet checked, vaccinated and spayed or neutered. We are funded solely by donations and all donations go directly to the care of our animals.

Properly and safely caring for our animals includes maintaining our facility. We have recently completed the replacement and repair of gates and the fencing in the dog kennels. This was a large expense, in addition to some very hefty vet bills this year. This project was jointly funded by a grant from the Cleopatra Fund of the Community Foundations of the Hudson Valley and very generous donations from two of our volunteers. We thank everyone involved for their help with this project.

Our next major (and expensive) project is tree removal in the exercise yard. Some trees have already fallen, others need to be cut down, and they all need to be cut up and carted away. Estimates are in the high thousands but with the help of our generous supporters, we're hoping to get this work completed as soon as possible. It's important for the safety of our volunteers as well as our dogs—they're out in the yard every day.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank all our dedicated volunteers who work tirelessly on a daily basis (especially during this pandemic) to tend to the animals in our care, help to maintain our buildings and grounds, and organize and participate in fundraising events. Many thanks also to all the wonderful and generous people who support our work with donations and sponsorships year after year. Without our network of volunteers and donors working as a team, we could not help all the needy animals that come through our doors. We wish all of you a wonderful holiday season and a happy and healthy (especially healthy) coming year.


